#### **Catholics and Cremation**

The Vatican issued new guidance about cremation in 2017. While the church is not opposed to cremation, it recommends that cremated remains of the deceased be buried in a cemetery or sacred space set aside for burial. Cremated remains should not be kept in in a residence for a lengthy period, nor are they to be scattered in the air, on or at sea. They should also not be preserved in mementos, such as jewelry or similar objects, nor divided among family members. This stance is based on the sacredness of the human body, created in the image of God. If cremains become part of jewelry, for example, what becomes of the cremains in a few years? Will they be sold at a garage sale? Will future generations revere the remains of your loved ones as much as you do?
