Where did the Collection Go?

You may have noticed at last week's Mass that we have a different procedure for the collection. Once the collection is brought forward with the other gifts, two ushers will immediately deposit the money bags into a drop safe that was purchased to secure the collection for all three (3) Masses. After depositing the bags into the drop safe, the ushers will sign a Safe Control Log to verify that the money was deposited. The reason for this new procedure is for the protection of the collection. The office staff felt that since there is no longer a priest in residence, and deacon may not be available at all the Masses, a secure procedure for the collection is necessary.

¿A dónde fue la colección?

Es posible que haya notado en la Misa de la semana pasada que tenemos un procedimiento diferente para la colecta. Una vez que se adelanta la colecta con los otros obsequios, dos ujieres depositarán inmediatamente las bolsas de dinero en una caja fuerte que se compró para asegurar la colecta de las tres (3) Misas. Después de depositar las bolsas en la caja fuerte, los ujieres firmarán un Registro de control de la caja fuerte para verificar que se depositó el dinero. El motivo de este nuevo procedimiento es la protección de la colección. El personal de la oficina consideró que, dado que ya no hay un sacerdote residente y es posible que el diácono no esté disponible en todas las Misas, es necesario un procedimiento seguro para la colecta.

Please note that if you are a member of one parish but attend Mass at another in our "Family of Parishes, or "FoP," your offertory envelopes or other donations marked for your "home" parish will be delivered to that parish, regardless of at which Mass they are collected.

Restoration of the Precious Blood

Beginning with the Holy Saturday Vigil and Easter Sunday Masses, the Precious Blood will be made available at all Masses. Extra Ministers of Holy Communion will be needed for the distribution of the cup. If you plan to attend the 8:00 pm Vigil Mass, or one of the two Masses on Easter Sunday, please call the office to let the staff know so you can be added to the Eucharistic Minister schedule. In addition, if your preference for the weekend Mass is for the 5:30 pm Mass, or the 10:00 am Mass, or the 11:30 am Spanish Mass, please tell us so we can add you to the regular weekend Mass schedule. Please note: If you are uncomfortable receiving from the cup because of a compromised immune system or for other reasons, the cup is optional. You will receive Christ in his fullness: Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity if you choose to receive only the Body of Christ. Also, if anyone is gluten intolerant, we do have the option of ordering low gluten hosts. Again, please contact the rectory staff if you wish to receive a consecrated low gluten host at Mass.

Restauración de la Preciosa Sangre

Comenzando con la Vigilia del Sábado Santo y las Misas del Domingo de Pascua, la Preciosa Sangre estará disponible en todas las Misas. Se necesitarán ministros adicionales de la Sagrada Comunión para la distribución de la copa. Si planea asistir a la Misa de Vigilia de las 8:00 pm, o a una de las dos Misas del Domingo de Pascua, llame a la oficina para informar al personal para que pueda ser agregado al horario del Ministro Eucarístico. Además, si su preferencia para la Misa del fin de semana es la Misa de las 5:30 p. m., o la Misa de las 10:00 a. m., o la Misa en español de las 11:30 a. m., infórmenos para que podamos agregarlo al horario regular de Misas del fin de semana . Tenga en cuenta: si no se siente cómodo recibiendo de la taza debido a un sistema inmunológico comprometido o por otras razones, la taza es opcional. Recibirás a Cristo en su plenitud: Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad si eliges recibir solo el Cuerpo de Cristo. Además, si alguien es intolerante al gluten, tenemos la opción de pedir hostias bajas en gluten. Nuevamente, comuníquese con el personal de la rectoría si desea recibir una hostia consagrada baja en gluten en la Misa.


Chicken BBQ & Benefit
