St. Mary's (1854 to 1975) to St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (1975 to 2023) Part 3

As Father Albinus was busy establishing his role as Pastor of St. Mary's, he was joined by Father Gaudentius Rossi, a Passionist from the English Province of the Passionist community. Fr. Gaudentius was the first Passionist to work in the Buffalo diocese. In 1856, Fr. Gaudentius conducted the Retreat for the Buffalo clergy. Immediately afterward, he opened a Mission in the recently completed St. Joseph Cathedral, one of the first parish missions in that beautiful edifice.

Father Gaudentius had come to Dunkirk with Brother Boniface Feld, the first candidate to enter the Novitiate in Pittsburgh. Shortly afterward, Father John Baptist Baudinelli was assigned to St. Mary's, followed by Fathers Aloysius Gregg and Andrew McGurgan, the first Passionist ordained in this Country.

On July 6, 1861, a charter of incorporation was drawn up, for legal protection, under the title of “The Dunkirk Benevolent, Missionary and Scientific Institution,” which declared its object to be the “aid, support and instruction of missionaries for the benefit of the poor and the instruction and spiritual education of the people of Dunkirk.” Their expense book shows how the Passionist community planned to fulfill their obligations. The “Month of December 1860 showed travel expenses at \$1.70, provisions for the house at \$10, contributions to the poor was \$5.00, and donation to the Sisters of Charity in Buffalo totaled \$40.00. The total expense account was \$56.70.

In November of that year, Bishop Timon legally transferred ownership of the Church, School, and Cemetery to the Passionist Monastic Corporation. With priests to assist him, especially at the mission stations, Father Albinus went ahead with plans for the new Monastery. A track of land adjacent to the Church on Washington Avenue was purchased, and on the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity, May 26, 1861, the cornerstone was blessed by Bishop Timon. On Sunday, July 20, 1862, the Monastery was blessed and officially opened under the patronage of the Seven Sorrows of Mary.



How the Passionists must have rejoiced on that day! Now they could begin “aiding, supporting and instructing missionaries for the benefit of the poor.” Within a few days of the opening of the new Monastery, six theological students took up residence. The new students came from Pittsburgh, accompanied by Father

John Thomas Stepanini, who was to be their professor. The students were

Charles and Frederick Lang, Basil Keating, Philip Birk, William Geoghan, and Martin Meagher. On September 7, 1862, Bishop Timon returned to Saint Mary's to ordain the Lang brothers (Charles and Frederick) and Martin Meagher to the priesthood. On March 28th, the year following, Bishop Timon ordained William Geoghan and Basil Keating in St. Joseph's Cathedral. Philip Birk was ordained on July 23, 1865.

Mientras el Padre Albinus estaba ocupado estableciendo su papel como Pastor de St. Mary's, se le unió el Padre Gaudentius Rossi, un Pasionista de la Provincia Inglesa de la comunidad Pasionista. El padre Gaudentius fue el primer pasionista que trabajó en la diócesis de Búfalo. En 1856, el P. Gaudentius dirigió el Retiro para el clero de Búfalo. Inmediatamente después, abrió una Misión en la recién terminada Catedral de San José, una de las primeras misiones parroquiales en ese hermoso edificio.

El Padre Gaudentius había llegado a Dunkerque con el Hermano Boniface Feld, el primer candidato que ingresó en el Noviciado de Pittsburgh. Poco después, el padre Juan Bautista Baudinelli fue destinado a St, seguido por los padres Aloysius Gregg y Andrew McGurgan, los primeros pasionistas ordenados en este país.

El 6 de julio de 1861, se redactó un acta constitutiva, para su protección legal, bajo el título de “Institución Benévola, Misionera y Científica de Dunkerque”, que declaraba que su objeto era la “ayuda, apoyo e instrucción de misioneros en beneficio de los pobres y la instrucción y educación espiritual del pueblo de Dunkerque”. Su libro de gastos muestra cómo la comunidad pasionista planeaba cumplir con sus obligaciones. El “mes de diciembre de 1860 mostró gastos de viaje por \$1.70, provisiones para la casa por \$10, contribuciones a los pobres por \$5.00, y donaciones a las Hermanas de la Caridad en Buffalo por un total de \$40.00”. La cuenta total de gastos ascendía a 56,70 dólares.

En noviembre de ese año, el Obispo Timon transfirió legalmente la propiedad de la Iglesia, la Escuela y el Cementerio a la Corporación Monástica Pasionista. Con sacerdotes para ayudarlo, especialmente en los puestos de misión, el Padre Albinus siguió adelante con los planes para el nuevo Monasterio. Se compró una pista de tierra adyacente a la Iglesia en la Avenida Washington, y en la Fiesta de la Santísima Trinidad, el 26 de mayo de 1861, la piedra angular fue bendecida por el Obispo Timon. El domingo 20 de julio de 1862, el monasterio fue bendecido e inaugurado oficialmente bajo el patrocinio de los Siete Dolores de María.



¡Cómo debieron alegrarse los Pasionistas aquel día! Ahora podían misioneros en favor de los pobres”. Pocos días después de la apertura del se instalaron seis estudiantes de teología. Los de Pittsburgh, acompañados por el padre John Thomas Stepanini, que iba a ser

su profesor. Los estudiantes eran Charles y Frederick Lang, Basil Keating, Philip Birk, William Geoghan y Martin Meagher. El 7 de septiembre de 1862, el obispo Timon volvió a Saint Mary's para ordenar sacerdotes a los hermanos Lang (Charles y Frederick) y a Martin Meagher. El 28 de marzo del año siguiente, el obispo Timon ordenó sacerdotes a William Geoghan y Basil Keating en la catedral de St. Joseph. Philip Birk fue ordenado el 23 de julio de 1865.
