**St. Mary's (1854 to 1975) to St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (1975 to 2023) Part 4**



St. Mary's Monastery was now a canonically established Monastery. It was at the time the smallest Monastery in the Province of St. Paul of the Cross. Over the course of 113 years, even though renovations and additions took place, thousands of Passionists took up residence in this small but august Monastery, getting up in the middle of the night to chant the Psalms of David and listening to the lessons of the Prophets, the glorious Apostles and Evangelists, the Confessors, Virgins, and Martyrs, then retiring to their rooms for another three hours rest only to return to the chapel for the canonical hours of "Prime" and "Tierce" and the celebration of daily Mass. After Mass, the men would attend to their duties: the lay-brothers to the kitchen and workshop, the students to their books and classroom, the priests to their missionary or parochial labors.

What was Pastor Father Albinus doing during this time? Well, in 1862, he had the brick walls of the Church tower elevated six feet and spire erected, at a cost of \$900. Meanwhile, the church debt was paid in full and parish societies were organized. In the summer of the year, Father Albinus consecrated a small church in Dayton, New York, under the patronage of Blessed Paul of the Cross, as well as a cemetery adjacent to the church. Five years remained until Paul of the Cross' canonization in 1867 and the Passionists could change "Blessed Paul of the Cross" to St. Paul of the Cross.

In 1863, Fr. John Baptist Baudinelli was elected Rector of Saint Mary's in what was the first Provincial Chapter of the Province. This allowed Fr. Albinus to step back from his administrative duties and affording him the opportunity to resume the work that was so dear to him – the giving of Missions and Retreats. "Father John," as the people called him, spent seventeen years of his life in Dunkirk, nine of them as Rector of Saint's Mary's. His first term in office will be remembered for the purchase of six lots adjacent to the small monastic holding; for the legal transfer of properties between the Monastic Corporation and that of St. Mary's Orphanage. The Sisters of St. Joseph established St. Mary's Orphan Asylum in 1857.



one on Bennett Road is given as "St. Mary's Orphanage." The St. Joseph's Farm and School (St. Mary's Orphanage) was established in 1873 for male orphans on a sixty acre plot purchased on Bennett Road in Dunkirk. The farm provided for the nutritional needs of the Dunkirk missions.

Although there were far more girls' names, boys were included up through 1905. After that the boys resided at the St. Mary's Farm and School on Bennett Road. (In the directories for 1906 through 1957, the orphanage on Buffalo Street [today's Washington Avenue] is given as "St. Mary's Orphan Asylum," while the

El Monasterio de Santa María era ahora un Monasterio canónicamente establecido. Era entonces el Monasterio más pequeño de la Provincia de San Pablo de la Cruz. A lo largo de 113 años, a pesar de las renovaciones y ampliaciones, miles de Pasionistas residieron en este pequeño pero augusto Monasterio,

levantándose en mitad de la noche para cantar los Salmos de David y escuchando las lecciones de los Profetas, de los gloriosos Apóstoles y Evangelistas, de los Confesores, Vírgenes y Mártires, retirándose después a sus habitaciones para descansar otras tres horas, sólo para volver a la capilla para las horas canónicas de "Prime" y "Tierce" y la celebración de la Misa diaria. Después de la misa, los hombres se dedicaban a sus tareas: los hermanos laicos a la cocina y al taller, los estudiantes a los libros y al aula, los sacerdotes a sus labores misioneras o parroquiales.

¿Qué hizo el Padre Albinus durante este tiempo? Bueno, en 1862, hizo elevar seis pies las paredes de ladrillo de la torre de la iglesia y erigió una aguja, a un costo de 900 dólares. Mientras tanto, la deuda de la iglesia fue pagada en su totalidad y se organizaron sociedades parroquiales. En el verano de ese año, el Padre Albinus consagró una pequeña iglesia en Dayton, Nueva York, bajo el patrocinio del Beato Pablo de la Cruz, así como un cementerio adyacente a la iglesia. Faltaban cinco años para la canonización de Pablo de la Cruz en 1867 y los Pasionistas pudieron cambiar "Beato Pablo de la Cruz" por San Pablo de la Cruz.

En 1863, el P. Juan Bautista Baudinelli fue elegido Rector de Santa María en lo que fue el primer Capítulo Provincial de la Provincia. Esto permitió al P. Albinus retirarse de sus tareas administrativas y le dio la oportunidad de reanudar el trabajo que le era tan querido: dar Misiones y Retiros. El "Padre John", como le llamaba la gente, pasó diecisiete años de su vida en Dunkerque, nueve de ellos como Rector de Saint's Mary's. Su primer mandato será recordado por la compra de seis terrenos adyacentes a la pequeña explotación monástica; por el traspaso legal de propiedades entre la Corporación Monástica y la del Orfanato de Santa María. Las Hermanas de San José crearon el Asilo de Huérfanos de Santa María en 1857.



Aunque había muchos más nombres de niña, se incluyeron los de niño hasta 1905. A partir de entonces, los chicos residieron en la St. Mary's Farm and School, en Bennett Road. (En los directarios de 1906 hasta 1957, el orfanato de Buffalo Street [actual Washington Avenue] aparece como "St. Mary's Orphan Asylum", mientras que el de Bennett Road aparece como "St. Mary's Orphanage". Joseph's Farm and School (Orfanato de Santa María) se estableció en 1873 para huérfanos varones en una parcela de sesenta acres adquirida en Bennett Road, en Dunkerque. La granja cubría las necesidades alimenticias de las misiones de Dunkerque.
