**St. Mary's (1854 to 1975) to St. Elizabeth Ann Seton
(1975 to 2023) Part 5**

First Quarter (1863-1869)

In 1863, Father Guido Matassi was elected Rector of Saint Mary's. This genial priest was a great lover of the poor and a man of vision. In 1867, he began the erection of Columbus Hall. This building served two purposes: to make a more suitable building for the school children and simultaneously open the space to the public to rent the large auditorium. The hope was the revenue from these rentals would maintain the expense of the school. To this end, a three-story brick building was erected so that only the first floor contained classrooms, the second and third floors being one large hall with galleries. It was named "Columbus Hall," probably because it would be viewed as more accessible to the public. The cost, not including the purchasing of lots, was over \$23,000. At about this time, Father Guido installed a clock and another large bell in the church tower. This was known for years as "The Town Clock."

In 1869, Father Guido built the first addition to the Monastery on the north side: a small one-story brick room to serve as a private chapel for the Religious, connected by a passageway to the church. The private chapel parallels Saints Paul's Chapel on the south side of the building, where two confessionals were added.

In 1867, St. Paul of the Cross, the founder of the Passionist, was canonized in Rome. The following year, Father Guido bought another Universalist Church (the first church purchased in Sherman) at Sinclairville for \$1000, dedicating it to Saint Paul of the Cross.

Father Guido was succeeded in 1869 by Father Martin Meagher, and shortly after assuming the charge, the new school building and auditorium were opened. Father Martin was followed in 1872 by Father Basil Keating, who remained in office for two terms.

In the year following, Fr. Basil's made repairs and renovation to St. Mary's church. The repairs and renovation included raising the Church roof to form a clerestory (a high section of wall that contains windows above eye level. Its purpose is to admit light, fresh air, or both. Historically, clerestory denoted an upper level of a Roman basilica or of the nave of a the Romanesque or Gothic church, the walls of which rise above the roof-lines of the lower aisles and are pierced with windows.), slating the roof and arching the whole interior in Gothic style. By the time the work was completed, only the outer walls and tower remained unchanged. The total expenditure was \$16,000. By year's end, the church was rededicated by the second Bishop of Buffalo, the Rt. Rev. Stephen Ryan.

Primer trimestre (1863-1869)

En 1863, el padre Guido Matassi fue elegido rector de Santa María. Este genial sacerdote era un gran amante de los pobres y un hombre de visión. En 1867, inició la construcción del Columbus Hall. Este edificio tenía dos propósitos: hacer un edificio más adecuado para los niños de la escuela y, simultáneamente, abrir el espacio al público para alquilar el gran auditorio. Se esperaba que los ingresos de estos alquileres permitieran sufragar los gastos de la escuela. Para ello, se construyó un edificio de ladrillo de tres plantas, de modo que sólo la primera contuviera aulas, y la segunda y la tercera, aulas.

El segundo y el tercer piso eran una gran sala con galerías. Se le dio el nombre de "Columbus Hall", probablemente porque se consideraría más accesible al público. El coste sin incluir la compra de terrenos, fue de más de 23.000 dólares. Por aquel entonces, el padre Guido instaló un reloj y otra gran campana en la torre de la iglesia. Esto se conoció durante años como "El reloj del pueblo".

En 1869, el padre Guido construyó la primera ampliación del monasterio en el lado norte: una pequeña habitación de ladrillo de una sola planta que serviría de capilla privada para las religiosas, conectada por un pasadizo con la iglesia. La capilla privada es paralela a la capilla de San Pablo en el lado sur del edificio, donde se añadieron dos confesionarios.

En 1867, San Pablo de la Cruz, fundador de los Pasionistas, fue canonizado en Roma. Al año siguiente, el Padre Guido compró otra Iglesia Universalista (la primera iglesia comprada en Sherman) en Sinclairville por \$1000, dedicándola a San Pablo de la Cruz.

El Padre Guido fue sucedido en 1869 por el Padre Martin Meagher, y poco después de asumir el cargo, el nuevo edificio de la escuela y el auditorio fueron inaugurados. Al padre Martin le sucedió en 1872 el padre Basil Keating, que permaneció en el cargo durante dos mandatos.

En el año siguiente, el padre Basil hizo reparaciones y renovaciones en la iglesia de Santa María. Las reparaciones y la renovación incluyeron elevar el techo de la Iglesia para formar un claristorio (una sección alta de la pared que contiene ventanas por encima del nivel de los ojos. Su finalidad es permitir la entrada de luz, aire fresco o ambos. Históricamente, el claristorio designaba el nivel superior de una basílica romana o de la nave de una iglesia románica o gótica, cuyos muros se elevan por encima de los tejados de las naves inferiores y están perforados con ventanas), la colocación de pizarras en el tejado y el arqueado de todo el interior en estilo gótico. Cuando se terminaron las obras, sólo permanecían inalterados los muros exteriores y la torre. El gasto total fue de 16.000 dólares. A finales de año, la iglesia fue dedicada de nuevo por el segundo obispo de Búfalo, el reverendo Stephen Ryan.
