St. Mary's (1854 to 1975) to St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (1975 to 2023) Part 6 First Quarter (1863-1889)

In 1871, a small church was built by the Passionist Fathers in Forestville under the patronage of the Blessed Virgin. Fr. Vincent and Fr. Angelo began the project, and the church was completed under the supervision of Fr. Andrew McGurgan. Also, at that time, the Passionist Fathers were attending the Mission Chapel in Gowanda, NY, which was finally given to the care of the parish priest of the Dayton Church on Easter Sunday in 1878. Towards the end of 1874, the Passionist Fathers were released from the care of Saint George's church, (the former Sacred Heart church) by the diocese, having attended it intermittently for ten years. Four German-speaking Passionists faithfully served St. George's church: Fathers Frederick Lang, Philip Birk, Daniel Rimmels, and Ignatius Sauer.

Fr. Martin was succeeded by Fr. Basil Keating, who remained the Rector for two years. Sadly, on Christmas Eve of December 1878, Father Basil suffered a paralytic stroke while offering the Midnight Mass. He died shortly afterward, resigning his office to Father Alphonsus Rossiter, who filled out his term. In that same year, one of the founders of the American Province of the Passionist Fathers, Father Anthony Calandri, died at St. Mary's on April 27th, the vigil of the Holy Feast of St. Paul of the Cross. Father Calandri was in the area during the Spring to conduct missions at French Creek and Sherman.

In 1879, Father John Baptist again returned to Saint Mary's as Rector. He was succeeded in 1881 by Father Guido Matassi. In the Spring of that year, Father Nilus Mastaiani, who had served as Vicar of St. Mary's for twelve years, was commissioned to open a new foundation of the Congregation in Argentina. That year was a year of extraordinary missionary activity, for the Passionists from Saint Mary's conducted the first missions ever given in the State of Arkansas. At about the same time, they established missions in the state of Nebraska.

In April 1882, the old pastoral residence, known commonly as “The Brethren House,” was sold and removed from the lot back of the Monastery Building. In 1885, a small property between the Monastery and the School was purchased by the Passionists for \$1300. This property was immediately turned over to the school children for a playground.

St. Mary's (1854 a 1975) a St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (1975 a 2023) Parte 6 Primer Trimestre (1863-1889)

En 1871, una pequeña iglesia fue construida por los Padres Pasionistas en Forestville bajo el patrocinio de la Santísima Virgen. El P. Vincent y el P. Angelo comenzaron el proyecto, y la iglesia fue terminada bajo la supervisión del P. Andrew McGurgan. También, en esa época, los Padres Pasionistas atendían la Capilla de la Misión en Gowanda, NY, que finalmente fue entregada al cuidado del párroco de la Iglesia de Dayton el Domingo de Pascua de 1878. A finales de 1874, la diócesis liberó a los Padres Pasionistas del cuidado de la iglesia de San Jorge (la antigua iglesia del Sagrado Corazón), a la que habían asistido intermitentemente durante diez años. Cuatro Pasionistas de habla alemana sirvieron fielmente a la iglesia de San Jorge: Los padres Frederick Lang, Philip Birk, Daniel Rimmels e Ignatius Sauer.

El P. Martin fue sucedido por el P. Basil Keating, que permaneció como rector durante dos años. Lamentablemente, en la Nochebuena de diciembre de 1878, el Padre Basil sufrió un ataque de parálisis mientras oficiaba la Misa del Gallo. Murió poco después, dejando su cargo al padre Alphonsus Rossiter, que completó su mandato. Ese mismo año, uno de los fundadores de la Provincia Americana de los Padres Pasionistas, el padre Anthony Calandri, falleció en Santa María el 27 de abril, vigilia de la Santa Fiesta de San Pablo de la Cruz. El padre Calandri estuvo en la zona durante la primavera para dirigir misiones en French Creek y Sherman.

En 1879, el padre Juan Bautista regresó de nuevo a Santa María como rector. Le sucedió en 1881 el padre Guido Matassi. En la primavera de ese año, el padre Nilus Mastaiani, que había sido vicario de Santa María durante doce años, recibió el encargo de abrir una nueva fundación de la Congregación en Argentina. Ese año fue un año de extraordinaria actividad misionera, ya que los Pasionistas de Santa María llevaron a cabo las primeras misiones que se dieron en el Estado de Arkansas. Casi al mismo tiempo, establecieron misiones en el estado de Nebraska.

En abril de 1882, la antigua residencia pastoral, conocida comúnmente como “La Casa de los Hermanos”, fue vendida y removida del lote detrás del edificio del Monasterio. En 1885, una pequeña propiedad entre el Monasterio y la Escuela fue comprada por los Pasionistas por \$1300. Esta propiedad fue entregada inmediatamente a los niños de la escuela para un patio de recreo.

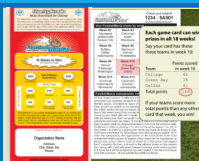
Boletos de Lotería
