St. Mary's (1854 to 1975) to St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (1975 to 2023) Part 8

Third Quarter (1912 - 1932)

In 1912, negotiations were being made by the legal corporation of the Monastery, to acquire a property of seventy-two acres on West Lake Road, between Point Gratiot and Van Buren. The property known as "Hemlock Grange," was finally purchased from a Mrs. Rumsey for the sum of \$23,000 and possession was taken on November 1, 1913.

In the Summer of 1914, Father Herbert McDevitt was elected Rector and, for the first time in the history of St. Mary's, the office of Rector was separated from that of Pastor. At the same time, funds that belonged to the parish were transferred from the legal corporation to a new corporation called, "St. Mary's Roman Catholic Church Society of Dunkirk." Father Oswin McGibbon was appointed Pastor.

Father Herbert, invited Father Bernardine Dusch of the Pittsburgh Monastery to come to Saint Mary's and stage his beautiful Passion Play, "Veronica's Veil." For a number of years thereafter, this Sacred Drama was an annual event in the parish and did much good, not only for the people who came from all parts of the diocese, but also for the participants who were parishioners of Saint Mary's. The Passionist continued their tradition of preaching and evangelizing and as they recorded their preaching engagements, they carefully noted their work with the non-Catholic. Over the course of years from 1863 to 1952, over sixteen hundred such preaching assignments were filled by the Fathers of Saint Mary's Monastery. This does not include such frequent one to three-day preaching engagements as "Forty-Hours," or "Perpetual-Novenas" preaching. In 1915, Father Colman Byrne was appointed Pastor of Saint Mary's Parish. He was given an assistant, a young priest by the name of Father Caspar Hartmann. In that year, nineteen professed Students were living in the Monastery.

In 1916, fire-escapes were erected at the rear of the Monastery and a grotto to Our Lady of Lourdes was blessed on the titular feast of the Church by the Passionist Bishop, the Rt. Rev. Paul Nussbaum. Bishop Nussbaum served as bishop of the Diocese of Corpus Christi in Texas (1913-1920) and as bishop of the Diocese of Sault Sainte Marie-Marquette in Michigan (1922-1935). Late in the summer of 1916, the steeple tower and church roof were repaired.

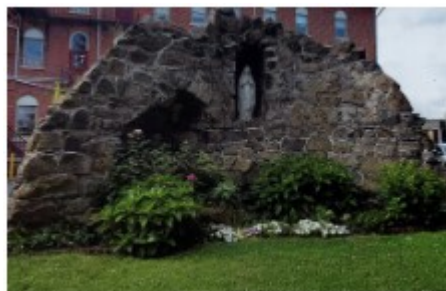
Tercer Trimestre (1912 - 1932)

En 1912, se estaban llevando a cabo negociaciones por parte de la corporación legal del Monasterio, para adquirir una propiedad de setenta y dos acres en West Lake Road, entre Point Gratiot y Van Buren. La propiedad, conocida como "Hemlock Grange", se compró finalmente a la Sra. Rumsey por la suma de 23.000 dólares y se tomó posesión de ella el 1 de noviembre de 1913. En el verano de 1914, el padre Herbert McDevitt fue elegido rector y, por primera vez en la historia de Santa María, el cargo de rector se separó del de párroco. Al mismo tiempo, los fondos que pertenecían a la parroquia fueron transferidos de la corporación legal a una nueva corporación llamada, "St. Mary's Roman Catholic Church Society of Dunkirk". El Padre Oswin McGibbon fue nombrado Párroco.

Padre Herbert, invitó al Padre Bernardine Dusch del Monasterio de Pittsburgh a venir a Santa María y escenificar su hermosa Obra de la Pasión, "El Velo de la Verónica". Durante varios años a partir de entonces, este Drama Sagrado fue un acontecimiento anual en la parroquia e hizo mucho bien, no sólo a la gente que venía de todas partes de la diócesis, sino también a los participantes que eran feligreses de Saint Mary's. Los pasionistas continuaron con su tradición de predicación y evangelización y, a medida que registraban sus compromisos de predicación, anotaban cuidadosamente su trabajo para los no católicos. A lo largo de los años que van de 1863 a 1952, los Padres del Monasterio de Santa María cumplieron más de mil seiscientas misiones de este tipo. Esto no incluye los frecuentes compromisos de predicación de uno a tres días como "Cuarenta Horas" o "Novenas Perpetuas".

En 1915, el padre Colman Byrne fue nombrado párroco de la parroquia de Santa María. Tuvo como ayudante a un joven sacerdote llamado Caspar Hartmann. En ese año, diecinueve estudiantes profesos vivían en el monasterio.

En 1916, se construyeron cortafuegos en la parte trasera del monasterio y el obispo pasionista, el reverendo Paul Nussbaum, bendijo una gruta dedicada a Nuestra Señora de Lourdes en la fiesta titular de la iglesia. Mons. Nussbaum fue obispo de la diócesis de Corpus Christi en Texas (1913-1920) y obispo de la diócesis de Sault Sainte Marie-Marquette en Michigan (1922-1935). A finales del verano de 1916, se repararon la torre del campanario y el tejado de la iglesia.
