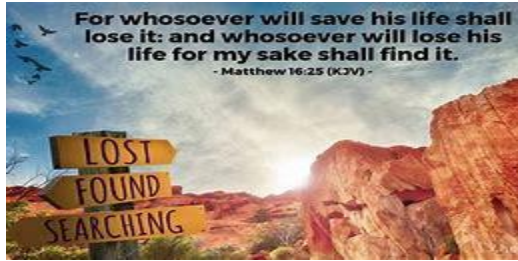
Upon reaching their 19th birthday should assume their own identity by registering with the parish.

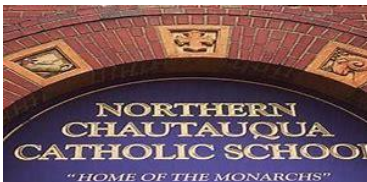
