HEALING MASSES

A Mass for Healing of the Sick in English will be celebrated on Thursday, October 6 at 7:00 PM in Church. And the following Thursday, October 13 at 7:00 PM, a Mass of Healing for the Sick will be offered in Spanish.

Following each Mass, Fr. Mark will celebrate the Anointing of the Sick. Those who are able to receive this Sacrament include:

1. Those who are dealing with a significant illness who have not been anointed within the past six months.

- Those who have been anointed within the past six months but have also had a worsening condition within that time period.
- Those over 65 years of age who may not have a specific illness, but are dealing with the significant physical pain and suffering.

Also, it is customary for those who are receiving this Sacrament that, if they are conscious of a serious sin, that they go to confession prior to receiving the Sacrament of Anointing. For this reason, confessions will be heard before Mass beginning at 5:30 PM. Finally, those who are not receiving the Sacrament of Anointing are welcome to remain after Mass, and following the Anointing of the Sick, Fr. Mark and Deacon Mike will be present to offer prayer with them for any personal intentions they may have. The schedule for both evenings (October 6 in English and October 13 in Spanish) will be:

- 5:30-6:45 PM – Confessions
- 7:00 PM – Mass for the Healing of the Sick
- 7:45 PM – Celebration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick
- 8:00 PM – Individual prayers with those who wish to offer personal prayer

MISAS DE SANACIÓN

El jueves 6 de octubre a las 7:00 p. m. en la Iglesia se celebrará una Misa por la Sanación de los Enfermos en inglés. Y el próximo jueves 13 de octubre a las 7:00 PM se ofrecerá una Misa de Sanación de Enfermos en español.

Después de cada Misa, el P. Mark celebrará la Unción de los Enfermos. Aquellos que pueden recibir este Sacramento incluyen:

- Aquellos que estén lidiando con una enfermedad significativa que no hayan sido ungidos en los últimos seis meses.
- Aquellos que han sido ungidos dentro de los últimos seis meses pero también han tenido una condición que empeora dentro de ese período de tiempo.
- Los mayores de 65 años que pueden no tener una enfermedad específica, pero están lidiando con un dolor y sufrimiento físico significativo.

Además, es costumbre para aquellos que están recibiendo este Sacramento que, si están conscientes de un pecado grave, se confiesen antes de recibir el Sacramento de la Unción. Por esta razón, las confesiones se escucharán antes de la misa a partir de las 5:30 PM. Finalmente, aquellos que no reciben el Sacramento de la Unción pueden quedarse después de la Misa y después de la Unción de los Enfermos, el P. Mark estará presente para ofrecer oración con ellos por cualquier intención personal que puedan tener.

- 5:30-6:45 PM – Confesiones
- 7:00 PM – Misa por la Sanación de los Enfermos
- 7:45 PM – Celebración del Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos
- 8:00 PM – Oraciones individuales con aquellos que deseen ofrecer oraciones personales

Road to Renewal Updates – 2 Phases

As we continue the *Road to Renewal*, the remaining Families will be designated to be formed within two Phases. Each Phase will consist of the following stages:

- **Activation Stage** - Parishes begin developing a Family Council and Family Action Plan. This phase lasts six months.
 - *Phase 1 FoPs will commence this stage November 1, 2022.*
 - *Phase 2 FoPs will commence this stage May 1, 2023.*
- **Inauguration Stage** - The date on which a Family of Parishes begins functioning as a Family.
 - *Phase 1 FoPs are estimated to be inaugurated May 1, 2023.*
 - *Phase 2 FoPs are estimated to be inaugurated November 1, 2023.*
