In the first centuries of the church, quite a few letters and gospels existed that Christians used for information and inspiration. It was the responsibility of the early popes and bishops, guided by the Holy Spirit, to determine which of these books were truly inspired. Pope Damasus, at the Council of Rome in AD 382, determined the official list of books, sometimes called the canon, that makes up the Catholic Bible. That list is complete, so no more books can ever be added or taken away.

Catholic Bibles have seven more books in the Old Testament than do most Protestant Bibles. This goes back to a disagreement over whether to use the original Greek or the Hebrew version of the Old Testament. The Greek version, has been accepted by the Church during the time of the Apostles and contains the Books of Tobit, Judith, 1 and 2 Maccabees, Wisdom, Sirach and Baruch. These seven books are sometimes call the Apocrypha (Greek for "hidden") or the deuterocanonical (Greek for "second canon") books. Many Protestant churches later decided to use the Hebrew version of the Old Testament, which does not contain these books.

HEALING MASSES

A Mass for Healing of the Sick in English will be celebrated on Thursday, October 6 at 7:00 PM in Church. And the following Thursday, October 13 at 7:00 PM, a Mass of Healing for the Sick will be offered in Spanish.

Following each Mass, Fr. Mark will celebrate the Anointing of the Sick. Those who are able to receive this Sacrament include:

Those who are dealing with a significant illness who have not been anointed within the past six months.

Those who have been anointed within the past six months but have also had a worsening condition within that time period.

Those over 65 years of age who may not have a specific illness, but are dealing with the significant physical pain and suffering.

Also, it is customary for those who are receiving this Sacrament that, if they are conscious of a serious sin, that they go to confession prior to receiving the Sacrament of Anointing. For this reason, confessions will be heard before Mass beginning at 5:30 PM.

Finally, those who are not receiving the Sacrament of Anointing are welcome to remain after Mass, and following the Anointing of the Sick, Fr. Mark and Deacon Mike will be present to offer prayer with them for any personal intentions they may have.

Después de cada Misa, el P. Mark celebrará la Unción de los Enfermos. Aquellos que pueden recibir este Sacramento incluyen:

Aquellos que estén lidiando con una enfermedad significativa que no hayan sido ungidos en los últimos seis meses.

Aquellos que han sido ungidos dentro de los últimos seis meses pero también han tenido una condición que empeora dentro de ese período de tiempo.

Los mayores de 65 años que pueden no tener una enfermedad específica, pero están lidiando con un dolor y sufrimiento físico significativo.

Además, es costumbre para aquellos que están recibiendo este Sacramento que, si están conscientes de un pecado grave, se confiesen antes de recibir el Sacramento de la Unción. Por esta razón, las confesiones se escucharán antes de la misa a partir de las 5:30 PM.

Finalmente, aquellos que no reciben el Sacramento de la Unción pueden quedarse después de la Misa y después de la Unción de los Enfermos, el P. Mark estará presente para ofrecer oración con ellos por cualquier intención personal que puedan tener.
