

Pastor's Message

Benefit of the doubt

Sometimes it's hard to be nice to some people. It's something I struggle with. People who want to jump down your throat for the smallest mistake, or criticize for something they have no idea about.

I often think about this when someone is driving like a madman down the thruway. They cut you off, weave in and out of traffic and in your mind some nasty things are thought (hopefully not said). My spiritual director used to tell me when I would complain to give the people the benefit of the doubt. Maybe that person speeding has a pregnant wife in labor and needs to get to the hospital. Maybe the person who isn't' paying attention to the road just lost a loved one. We don't know.

Almost everyday this week I have gotten complaints, some small things and some bigger things, and that comes with the territory. Before we complain and get angry, let us ask ourselves, do I know what that person is going through? I hope that each one of us can be radically hospitable to everyone. I've had non-Catholics tell me that they always feel judged and unwelcome by Catholics. That's not right and that's not what we are called to be.

There was a song we always used to sing at my grammar school masses, "they will know we are Christians by our love". Let us be that example at our church and in our community, so people can say "those Catholics are filled with joy and love. I want to be one!"
