A note from Fr. Mark - Una nota del P. Marcos

Dear Friends,

Thank you for coming to Mass this weekend! This coming Tuesday, we celebrate the Feast of All Saints. Personally, it is one of my favorite celebrations of the liturgical year. From an early age, the greatness of the Saints impressed me deeply. I recall reading a children's Bible when I was a boy and being totally taken in by the lives and martyrdoms of St. Paul and St. Peter. Over the years, I learned about many Saints at my Catholic Elementary School, St. Aloysius Gonzaga. I recall being about 10 years old and one of the Sisters at our School telling us the story of a Martyr. I think in an effort to allay any fears of the kids in the class, Sister commented, "Don't worry kids, this kind of thing won't happen to you. It doesn't happen in this part of the world anymore ..." When she said that, I remember feeling pretty disappointed. I suppose that kids sometimes have a desire to imitate the vigor and courageous faith of the Saints.

While serving in the Belize Missions in 2001 and 2002, I read many books - and a good number of them were biographies of the Saints. I read the life of St. John Vianney, St. Robert Bellarmine, the autobiography of St. Therese of Liseux, and that of St. Margaret Mary, among others. In the years that followed I read books on the lives of St. Bernadette, St. Maximilian Kolbe, St. John Paul II, St. Theophane Venard, St. Paul VI, Sts. Louis & Zelie Martin, St. Louis de Montfort, St. Peter Julian, and a bunch of others. All of their lives are incredibly inspiring.

The Feast of All Saints we celebrate on Tuesday calls to mind, most especially, those Saints and Martyrs who are unknown, whose stories cannot be recounted. What an amazing and mysterious Feast. I want to be in that number and I want you to be in that number also! We should all be Saints. We can recall this week the wise words of Leon Bloy who said, "The only real sadness, the only real failure, the only great tragedy in life, is not to become a Saint." I encourage you to read the lives and learn the personal stories of our brothers and sisters, the Saints. Their example lends us courage and can help guide our lives in the best of ways. Speaking of Saints marching in ... one of our Masses finally hit the century mark! That's right! We had 101 people at the 11:30 Spanish Mass last Sunday. Let's keep it there and add another. I hope and pray that our Spanish Mass continues to increase in attendance. And I wonder which Mass will be next to reach 100?

¡Gracias por venir a Misa este fin de semana! Este próximo martes, celebramos la Fiesta de Todos los Santos. En lo personal, es una de mis celebraciones favoritas del año litúrgico. Desde temprana edad, la grandeza de los Santos me impresionó profundamente. Recuerdo haber leído una Biblia para niños cuando era niño y estar totalmente cautivado por las vidas y los martirios de San Pablo y San Pedro. A lo largo de los años, aprendí sobre muchos santos en mi escuela Católica, St. Aloysius Gonzaga. Recuerdo tener unos 10 años y una de las Hermanas de mi escuela nos contaba la historia de un Mártir. Creo que en un esfuerzo por disipar los temores de los niños de la clase, la Hermana comentó: "No se preocupen, niños, este tipo de cosas no les sucederá a ustedes. Ya no sucede en esta parte del mundo..." Cuando dijo eso, recuerdo que me sentí bastante decepcionado. Supongo que a veces los niños tienen el deseo de imitar el vigor y la fe valiente de los Santos. Mientras prestaba servicio en las Misiones de Belice en 2001 y 2002, leí muchos libros, y muchos de ellos eran biografías de los santos. Leí la vida de San Juan María Vianney, San Roberto Belarmino, la autobiografía de Santa Teresita de Liseux y la de Santa Margarita María, entre otros. En los años que siguieron, leí libros sobre la vida de Santa Bernardita, San Maximiliano Kolbe, San Juan Pablo II, San Teofán Venard, San Pablo VI, Santos Luis & Celda Martín, San Luis de Montfort y muchos otros. Todas sus vidas son increíblemente inspiradoras.

La Fiesta de Todos los Santos que celebramos el martes recuerda, muy especialmente, a aquellos Santos y Mártires que son desconocidos, cuyas historias no se pueden contar. ¡Qué fiesta tan asombrosa y misteriosa! ¡Quiero estar en ese número y quiero que tú también estés en ese número! Todos debemos ser santos. Podemos recordar esta semana las sabias palabras de Leon Bloy, quien dijo: "La única tristeza real, el único fracaso real, la única gran tragedia en la vida, es no convertirse en santo".

Los animo a leer las vidas y conocer las historias personales de nuestros hermanos y hermanas, los santos. Su ejemplo nos da coraje y puede ayudarnos a guiar nuestras vidas de la mejor manera.
