Book of Remembrance

The Church has always taught us to pray for those who have gone into eternity. Even in the Old Testament, prayers and alms were offered for the souls of the dead. November is also the time when we end the current liturgical year. The Church uses this end of the liturgical year as a time to think of the end of life and the end of all things, keeping in mind the great hope that our earthly end is a transition into a new life in God's heavenly reality. We give thanks for those who have gone before us and we rejoice in their new life in heaven, keeping in mind our desire to one day join them heaven.

On the Baptismal Font is a Book of Remembrance in which we encourage you to enter the names of your loved ones who now rest in the loving arms of our Lord: *"The souls of the just are in the hands of God and no torment shall touch them."* (The Book of Wisdom, 3:1). As we journey to the end of this liturgical year and the start of Advent, we will pray for those listed in our Book of Remembrance.

Libro del recuerdo

En la Pila Bautismal hay un Libro de Recuerdos en el que te animamos a que escribas los nombres de tus seres queridos que ahora descansan en los brazos amorosos de nuestro Señor: *"Las almas de los justos están en las manos de Dios y ningún tormento los alcanzará. a ellos. (El Libro de la Sabiduría, 3:1).* A medida que avanzamos hacia el final de este año litúrgico y el comienzo del Adviento, oraremos por aquellos que figuran en nuestro Libro de Recuerdos.

Did You Know

Anyone can develop a blessing. All you have to do is think of someone who needs God's help or is celebrating a special occasion. Here are some occasions for which you could develop a blessing:

- Your parent's anniversary
- A friend's birthday
- When someone is sick
- When getting a new pet
- Before or after a test
- Before going on a trip or retreat

Once you have picked the occasion, all you have to do is think of some simple action and a prayer to go with it. The action could be making the Sign of the Cross, sprinkling with holy water, or just giving the person a hug. Here's an example of prayer you can use – but don't let it limit you; the best blessing is the one that comes from your heart!

Dear God, please bless (person's name) on her birthday (or the occasion).

She is your special daughter, full of goodness and love – just as you created her to be.

Send your Spirit upon her and fill her with peace, joy, and the strength to do your will.

I ask this blessing in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Sabías

Cualquiera puede desarrollar una bendición. Todo lo que tienes que hacer es pensar en alguien que necesita la ayuda de Dios o está celebrando una ocasión especial. Aquí hay algunas ocasiones para las que podría desarrollar una bendición:

- El aniversario de tus padres
- el cumpleaños de un amigo
- cuando alguien está enfermo
- Al tener una nueva mascota
- Antes o después de una prueba
- Antes de ir de viaje o retiro

Una vez que haya elegido la ocasión, todo lo que tiene que hacer es pensar en alguna acción simple y una oración que la acompañe. La acción podría ser hacer la Señal de la Cruz, rociar con agua bendita o simplemente darle un abrazo a la persona. Aquí hay un ejemplo de oración que puedes usar, pero no dejes que te limite; la mejor bendición es la que sale de tu corazón! Querido Dios, por favor bendice a (nombre de la persona) en su cumpleaños (o la ocasión). Ella es tu hija especial, llena de bondad y amor, tal como la creaste para que fuera. Envía tu Espíritu sobre ella y llénala de paz, de alegría y de fuerza para hacer tu voluntad. Te pido esta bendición en el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. Amén.
