Dear Friends, Many blessings to you and your families this week! A great priest I know once said that the Sacrament of Confession, is, simply, “going to God the Father to talk to him about the work he’s given you to do.”

I like that explanation! God wants to meet us in a living encounter. A living encounter that is real and effective. In the Sacrament of Reconciliation, or confession, God meets us once again, and by the simple confessing of our sins and the offering of a few prayers, he gives us the fullness of our lives back to us, new. He offers us the gift of freedom and restoration that he desired to give us from the cross. He does this because he cares for us and desires to lift the burdens that wear us down and weigh us down.

QUESTION OF THE WEEK --- PREGUNTA DE LA SEMANA

(taken from the YOUNG CATECHISM)

Who Instituted the Sacrament of Reconciliation?

Jesus himself instituted the Sacrament of Reconciliation when he showed himself to his apostles on Easter day and commanded them, “Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of anyone, they are forgiven; if you retain the sins of anyone, they are retained.”

Nowhere did Jesus express more beautifully what happens in the Sacrament of Reconciliation than in the parable of the Prodigal Son: We go astray, we are lost and can no longer cope. Yet our Father waits for us with great, indeed, infinite longing; he forgives us when we come back; he takes us in again, and forgives our sins. Jesus himself forgave the sins of many individuals; it was more important to him than working miracles! He regarded this as the great sign of the dawning of the Kingdom of God, in which all wounds are healed and all tears wiped away. Jesus forgave sins in the power of the Holy Spirit, and he handed that power on to his Apostles. We fall into the arms of our Heavenly Father when we go to a priest and confess.

Quien ha instituido el Sacramento de la Confesión?

Jesús mismo instituyó el Sacramento de Confesión cuando el día de Pascua se apareció a los Apóstoles y les dijo: “Reciban el Espíritu Santo. Los pecados serán perdonados a los que ustedes se los perdonen, ye serán retenidos a los que ustedes se los retengan.”

En ningún lugar ha expresado Jesús la forma más bella lo que sucede en el Sacramento de Confesión que en la parábola del hijo prodigo: nos extraviamos, nos perdemos, no podemos más. Pero Dios Padre nos espera con un deseo mayor e incluso infinito; nos perdona cuando regresamos; nos acepta siempre, perdona el pecado. Jesús mismo perdona los pecados a muchas personas; eso era más importante para el que hacer milagros. Veía en ello el gran signo de la llegada del reino de Dios, en el que todas las heridas serán sanadas y todas las lágrimas serán enjugadas. El poder del Espíritu Santo, en el que Jesús perdonaba los pecados, lo transmitió a sus Apóstoles. Cuando nos dirigimos a un sacerdote y nos confesamos, nos arrojamos a los brazos abiertos de nuestro Padre celestial.
