

Pastor's Message

Merry Christmas!

First, I would like to thank everyone for coming to this mass to celebrate Emmanuel (God with us). I know this year has been crazy, and you may not be at your regular church or at your regular time, but you came to praise God, so thank you! Also, if anyone is coming to any of our churches for the first time I would like to offer the warmest welcome into our family.

I was recently talking to parishioners who have told me they have had a change of heart with the family of parishes idea. At first, they stated that they really did not like the change, but understood that because of finances and the availability of priests they knew change was going to happen. 

The Nativity of the Lord

Take a moment to contemplate the symbols of the season. The angels stand as heralds of the good news, an emblem for each of us on this solemn feast of our own duty to spread the message that Christ is born and saves us from our sins. The wreath made of evergreens reminds us that God is one, without beginning or end. The candles recall the birth of him who is forever the Light of the world. Today, we celebrate the fact that God came to earth as a beautiful, innocent infant who rejects no one. We rejoice this day in the birth of Christ! 
